47TH RBC HERITAGE PRESENTED BY BOEING CHAMPION PORTRAIT UNVEILED AT THE ART LEAGUE OF HILTON HEAD

HILTON HEAD ISLAND, S.C., Thursday, October 1, 2015 — The portrait of the 47th RBC Heritage Presented by Boeing champion, Jim Furyk, was unveiled to sports and history enthusiasts of South Carolina at the Art League Gallery in the Arts Center of Coastal Carolina. The original oil painting of Furyk was painted by esteemed artist, West Fraser.

“It is tradition for the RBC Heritage to honor each champion of the tournament through an original portrait that is housed in the Harbour Town Clubhouse,” said Steve Wilmot, RBC Heritage Presented by Boeing tournament director. “Furyk’s painting will be presented and featured first at the Art League of Hilton Head Gallery for everyone to see.”
