HERITAGE CLASSIC FOUNDATION SCHOLAR APPLICATIONS AVAILABLE NOW

HILTON HEAD ISLAND, SC (September 18, 2017) – Applications for the 2018 Heritage Classic Foundation Scholar Awards are now available online for all Beaufort and Jasper County High School Seniors, Committee Chairman Scott Richardson announced today.

The Heritage Classic Foundation will name 8 new Scholars from the 2018 graduating class. Seniors in all Beaufort and Jasper County high schools are eligible to apply. Each Scholar will have an opportunity to receive a 4-year grant totaling up to \$18,000 to \$22,000.

Scholarship applications are reviewed on the basis of academic success, SAT/ACT score, community service, an essay written by the student and financial need. An interview is required by all finalists.

Since this Scholar program was instituted in 1993, 312 graduating seniors have been named Heritage Scholars. These grants, to a college of the student's choice, have totaled more than \$3.8 million.

The 2018 Scholars will be recognized at the 50th annual RBC Heritage Presented by Boeing to be conducted over the Harbour Town Golf Links, April 9-15, 2018.
